

With ~48 legislative days remaining...

- Debt ceiling
- Infrastructure bill
- \$3.5T budget resolution
- National Defense Authorization Act
- FY 2022 appropriations

*The House passed a CR that will fund the government through Dec. 3, but the Senate has not yet voted on the bill.



APPROPRIATIONS

In the House and Senate appropriations bills:

- **DOE overall**: \$45 billion
- EM: \$7.7 billion
- NNSA: \$20 billion
- **NE**: \$1.6 billion
- Science: \$7.4 billion
- Other notable issues:
 - PILT restored at Hanford and SRS
 - House bill directs DOE to identify interim storage site





- Plutonium pit production reporting and oversight
- Grants for defense environmental cleanup technology development
- No prohibition on HLW interpretation at Hanford
- Report on end-state contracting
